**ORDER GRANTING FOREIGN REPRESENTATIVE’S MOTION
FOLLOWING REMAND FROM THE SECOND CIRCUIT COURT OF APPEALS FOR
REVIEW PURSUANT TO 11 U.S.C. §§ 363(b) AND 1520(a)(2), AND DISAPPROVAL, IN
ACCORDANCE WITH THE FOREIGN REPRESENTATIVE’S BUSINESS
JUDGMENT, OF THE CONTEMPLATED SALE OF FAIRFIELD SENTRY LIMITED’S
SIPA CLAIM TO FARNUM PLACE, LLC**

The Court having considered the *Foreign Representative’s Motion Following Remand from the Second Circuit Court of Appeals for Review Pursuant to 11 U.S.C. §§ 363(b) and 1520(a)(2), and Disapproval, in Accordance with the Foreign Representative’s Business Judgment, of the Contemplated Sale of Fairfield Sentry, Limited’s SIPA Claim to Farnum Place, LLC* [Docket No. 752] (the “Motion”)¹ and the filings and evidence in support and opposition thereto; and it appearing that notice of the Motion was sufficient under the circumstances and that no other or further notice need be provided; and the Court having heard oral argument on the Motion on March 31, 2015; it is hereby **ORDERED** that:

1. For the reasons set forth in the *Memorandum Decision Granting Foreign Representative’s Motion to Disapprove Sale and Denying Farnum’s Motion to Modify the Recognition Order* [Docket. No. 792], the Motion is **GRANTED**.

¹ Capitalized terms not otherwise defined in this Order shall have the meaning ascribed thereto in the Motion.

2. The sale of Fairfield Sentry Limited's SIPA customer claim in the BLMIS proceedings to Farnum Place, LLC, on the terms set forth in the Trade Confirmation, is hereby disapproved and, accordingly, the Trade Confirmation is hereby disapproved.

3. This Court shall retain jurisdiction with respect to all matters arising from or relating to the implementation of this Order.
